

| Mike Jones lost a 1/7th scale model Spitfire on 20th<br>July.<br>It went down in a near vertical spin on a compass<br>bearing of almost exactly due North of the club's<br>flight line. He was able to estimate the compass<br>bearing by aligning its downward plunge with particu-<br>lar trees, and two fellow members were also able to<br>confirm approximately the same bearing. Unfortu-<br>nately the distance from the flight line to where the<br>plane fell is difficult to estimate, but we are agreed it<br>probably went down quite near to Scripps Road.<br>The Spitfire is marked on the wings and fuselage<br>with his name and address.
