SAFETY FIRST: Student Nights have been very busy with a fine group of newcomers being helped by dedicated instructors. With such a large crowd things can get a little chaotic. It is VERY important to follow our field rules and common sense. It is imperative that everyone helps insure the following:

DO NOT TAXI INTO THE PITS. Shut your engine/motor down on the far side of the pilot stations. Taxi up parallel to the flight line, not through an opening. The prop should never be facing in to the pit area

RETURN TRANSMITTERS TO THE IMPOUND AFTER EACH FLIGHT. That is where they should stay until you are ready to fly.

2.4 GHZ (SPREAD SPECTRUM) TRANSMITTERS MUST HAVE A PIN.

TAXI OR WALK OUT (IF HAND LAUNCHING) TO CENTERLINE OF THE RUNWAY BEFORE TAKING OFF.

CALL OUT YOUR INTENTIONS. NICE AND LOUD. "On the field, Hand launching, Taking off, Landing, etc. so that everyone can hear it.

If someone mentions something to you don't take it personally. Let's keep everyone safe!

THE ELECTRIC EVENT WAS ANOTHER SUCCESS: Thanks to Pete, Carolynn and Sam Foss for again hosting the event. Generous prizes from Hobby Lobby, Fancy Foam, R/C Report, Ross Jones (RJR Kool Tools), Flight Line Hobby, Castle Creations and Prop Shop made it a great day. A lot of newcomers had their first electric experience too.

The changes are important to comply with how our organization has evolved, the upcoming new DNR Lease and recommendations from the AMA. The proposed documents are on the website or can be obtained by calling me at 248-321-7934. I welcome your questions and comments in advance too.

Speaking of the new lease, we have negotiated a workable new lease with the DNR. It will require that each pilot sign in before flying, that we have "spotters" for full size aircraft (something we do already) and that we fly below 1,000 feet. Our annual fee has gone up to \$1,400.00 per year but we now have the opportunity to work it down by "providing goods and services" to the DNR.
