Just prior to the Red Bull races in Detroit I was invited to a meet and greet with two of the Red Bull pilots. The evening was hosted by Red Bull at the Detroit Brewing company. The two pilots I had the opportunity to meet were Michael Goulian and Kerby Chambliss. Both of these pilots fly the Red Bull races for the United States. The evening reminded me of our long standing Wednesday night discussions at Buffalo Wild Wings. 




