PRESIDENT'S MESSAGE...

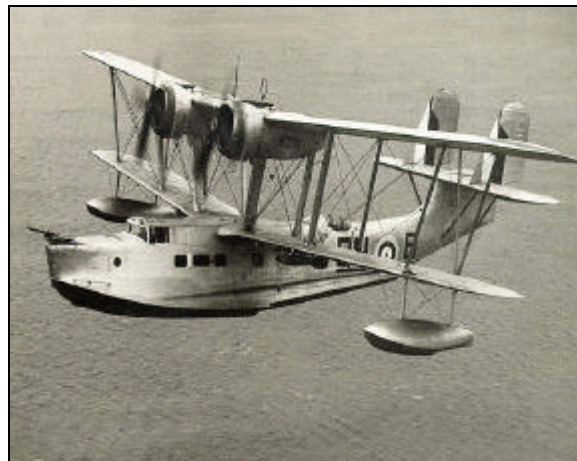
September is Here Already and the Big Float Fly is on Top of Us!
